

QUEENSLAND SINGLE-USE PLASTIC BAN Starts From September 1st 2021

Queensland Government joins South Australia, Western Australia, and Australian Capital Territory Government's in the first phase to ban single use plastic commencing 1st September 2021.

The ban includes single-use Plastic Straws, Stirrers, Cutlery, Plates and has expanded this list to Polystyrene takeaway food containers and cups.

This sets the direction for Queensland to be a part of the global solution to plastic pollution.







We strongly endorse the Single-use plastic Ban that are enacted around the world.

Compostable plastic and other Disposable Packaging items that are Certified to the Australian Standards (AS4736/AS5810) are not banned.
